

Albuquerque Balloon Festival & US National Parks

Tour pace

On this guided tour, you'll walk for about 2 hours daily across mostly flat terrain, including paved trails and dirt paths, with some hills and high altitudes.



Albuquerque, New Mexico

Day 1: Arrival in Albuquerque

Included meals: Dinner

Welcome to New Mexico! Arrive in Albuquerque and transfer to your hotel. Then, get together with your fellow travelers at this evening's welcome dinner.

Day 2: Albuquerque Balloon festival

Included meals: Breakfast

Wake up early to start your day at the Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta, the largest hot air balloon festival in the world. • Watch hundreds of balloons take to the sky en masse during the "mass ascension" • Enjoy access to a hospitality tent stocked with hot drinks and light snacks • In the evening, see the sky light up during the festival's AfterGlow Fireworks Show

Mesa Verde National Park

Day 3: Transfer to Mesa Verde National Park Included meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Cross the Colorado border, stopping in the Old West mining town of Durango, Colorado en route to Mesa Verde. • Pass by Chimney Rock and Abiqui Reservoir • Experience Durango's frozen-in-time charm

Kayenta, Arizona

Day 4: Mesa Verde National Park & transfer to Kayenta Included meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Take a guided tour of Mesa Verde National Park before transferring to Kayenta, Arizona through Monument Valley. • Enter Mesa Verde National Park on a sightseeing tour, and view fascinating 800-year-old cliff dwellings that honeycomb the walls of the canyon • Enjoy free time to visit either the gift shop or Spruce Tree House and Museum • Pass by Monument Valley's "Mexican Hat," a sombrero-shaped rock formation

The Grand Canyon

Day 5: Grand Canyon via Tuba City & Cameron Trading Post Included meals: Breakfast

Learn about the culture and history of the Navajo tribe during a stop at the Explore Navajo Interactive Museum. Then, pay a visit to the Cameron Trading Post before arriving at the Grand Canyon. Upon arrival, take a scenic walk along the South Rim with your Tour Director. • Marvel at the rocky formations that reflect millions of years of geological evolution • View the Colorado River running one mile below

Day 6: Free day at the Grand Canyon Included meals: Breakfast

Enjoy a full free day at the Grand Canyon to explore its rims and plateaus on your own or add an excursion.

Optional Excursion Grand Canyon Helicopter Ride \$199/pp

Enjoy a bird's-eye view of the Grand Canyon aboard a thrilling half-hour-long helicopter ride. Soar over the massive canyon, taking in a unique perspective on the striated terrain far below. From high above the canyon rim, you can begin to fully appreciate the immense scale of this natural wonder. Please note: This excursion is weather dependent. Save \$10 when you book this excursion up to 3 days before your tour departs (On-tour price: \$209).

Zion National Park

Day 7: Transfer to Zion National Park

Included meals: Breakfast

Pass by the beautiful Vermilion Cliffs National Monument before arriving in Zion National Park. • Discover why 19th-century Mormon settlers named the park after their heavenly city • View the yellowand orange-hued dramatically eroded sedimentary rocks • Take in magnificent vistas on an open-air tram ride with guided commentary

Salt Lake City, Utah

Day 8: Transfer to Salt Lake City via Bryce Canyon National Park Included meals: Breakfast

En route to Utah's capital city, stop for a visit to Bryce Canyon National Park. • Tour the park by bus and on foot • Take in up-close views of its distinctive pink limestone and sandstone formations, including awe-inspiring pinnacles and cones often referred to as hoodoos

Jackson, Wyoming

Day 9: Transfer to Jackson

Included meals: Breakfast

Cross into Wyoming on a scenic drive to the resort town of Jackson. Then, set out to explore Grand Teton National Park, home to the youngest mountain range in the Rockies. • Drive through stunning Logan Canyon and past turquoise Bear Lake • Tour Grand Teton National Park by bus and on foot • Try and spot elk, coyotes, black bears, wolves, and the elusive mountain lion Enjoy a free evening in Jackson.

Day 10: Yellowstone National Park

Included meals: Breakfast

Venture out for a full day of sightseeing in Yellowstone National Park, designated as the world's first national park in 1872. • Drive through the park with stops for photos • See cascading waterfalls, bubbling mud pots and the famous geyser, Old Faithful • Keep an eye out for the bison, mountain goats, moose, and grey wolves that call the park home

Day 11: Free day in Jackson

Included meals: Breakfast, Dinner

Enjoy a free day in Jackson to spend at your leisure. This evening, celebrate your trip with your fellow group members at a farewell dinner.

Day 12: Departure Included meals: Breakfast (excluding early morning departures)

Transfer to the airport for your flight home.
